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Preface:

This book is especially designed to reinforce basic functional reading skills for beginning readers. The book provides an array of systematically organized activities, enough to fill the program of reading instruction for the average and fast learners.

The pupils, however, in their most creative ways, can find other uses for the materials presented in the book. They will find the reading process a meaningful experience and, eventually, it will lead them to develop further interest in reading; but they should be properly guided, motivated, and carefully supervised. The authors, through the book, wish to share their significant experiences with other reading teachers. It is hoped that, by doing so, a progressive reading experience will be achieved.
