Preface:

This workbook, Learning to Read through Sounds and Letters, contains exercises designed for the use of preschool children. It is centered on the mastery of the three major skills namely: auditory discrimination, sound-to-letter association, and letter-to-sound association.

This is a first experience in learning to listen, produce, and associate sounds and letters for many preschool children. So to make this workbook more useful and meaningful, it is suggested that each exercise be used as a game to give the child more confidence in doing things easily. Chalkboard exercises using the pattern in the book may follow, after the child has mastered the sounds and their corresponding examples.
