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Preface:

The author has compiled in this vocabulary around 16,000 most common English words based on fundamental word lists compiled by educators from well-known universities in the United States like New York, Oxford, Columbia, and Chicago, with additions taken from dictionaries of Serrano-Laktaw, Eusebio T. Daluz and Sofronio Calderon, as well as those taken from the Institute of National Language vocabulary.

This simple vocabulary contains words used in everyday life and is very practical. The Tagalog equivalents have been chosen for their accuracy and simplicity in meaning as used in everyday conversations. In the preparation of this vocabulary, the author had in mind the non-Tagalog teachers and students who had been under her in the Philippine Normal School and in the high schools, whose capacity and immediate needs for an easy vocabulary listing she will understand. Tagalog equivalents which have been derived from Spanish or English words have been incorporated to enrich the National Language as time progresses.

The orthography of Tagalog words is in conformity with the rules of the official grammar published by the Institute of National Language.
